Mom and Dad decide for me!

From the start of pregnancy, breastfeeding information meetings, childbirth preparation sessions, the visit of the maternity ward and the obstetrical unit (nature room) will allow an informed choice for :

- live the pregnancy better,
- choose the best way to welcome Baby : we will support you in your delivery while respecting the physiology of labor and delivery,
 - opt for breastfeeding or bottle feeding.

• All trained for me!

Respect, listening, support, all staff at the center, trained, are committed to this policy.

Long live skin to skin, for you and me!

From birth, skin to skin is the best place to discover the world and getting to know... baby will show you that he is ready to breastfeed and breastfeed if you have chosen him. Continued in maternity and in neonatology for its benefits, temperature regulation, respiration, blood sugar...

Day and night with you, Mom and Dad!

Keeping your baby with you 24 hours a day reassures him.
You will thus discover its rhythms and its needs.
He knows how to show you his signs of awakening
whether breastfed or bottle fed.

The staff will be there to accompany you during breastfeeding and help you identify baby's rhythms and needs so that he gets the most out of his feeding.

If a separation is necessary for medical reasons, the team will facilitate meetings with your baby, a parent-child room will be reserved for you as soon as possible and we will accompany you in your breastfeeding plan if this is the case.



If mom gives me her milk, that's enough for me!

The World Health Organization advocates exclusive breastfeeding for at least six months, due to its many health benefits mothers and babies but also the importance of continuing breastfeeding beyond (up to 2 years and over)

with the appropriate food diversification.

Breast milk is enough for your baby's needs,
we avoid any other intake unless medically indicated.
To promote learning to feed, the use of pacifiers
and baby bottles will be avoided.
